Currency

The official currency is the Swiss franc (CHF). For information, 1 euro (€) is around 1,12 Swiss franc(CHF).

Weather

Temperatures in Geneva in late September usually reach an average maximum of 18 degrees Celsius during the daytime and fall to an average of 10 degrees Celsius overnight.

Hotel Location

The 4-star Royal Hotel is located at the heart of the city, a 5-minute walk from Geneva Train Station . When you arrive in Geneva in the luggage hall, just before going through customs, collect a ticket from the tpg machine (not the CFF ticket machine).

On exiting customs turn left and at the end, about 100 m on, go through a big revolving door and you're in the airport station. Take the first train that's leaving and get off at the first stop (about 6 minutes ride). Get down to street level and get to the main station square (there are essentially two exits to the station - if you find yourself in a relatively small street, you're in the back entrance - turn round and leave at the other end). Once you're in the main station square, turn left and the rue de Lausanne is the road leading away from the station. You're less than 5 minutes walk from the station.

Upon arrival at the Royal Hotel you will get a public transport card entitling to free use of buses and trams during your stay in Geneva.

About Geneva

Geneva is a city in Switzerland that lies at the southern tip of expansive Lac Léman (Lake Geneva). Surrounded by the Alps and Jura mountains, the city has views of dramatic Mont Blanc. Headquarters of Europe's United Nations and the Red Cross, it's a global hub for diplomacy and banking. French influence is widespread, from the language to gastronomy and bohemian districts like Carouge.

Geneva today is a product of the best of its history, drawing on its many cultural influences and providing a refuge of peace that serves as a model for the rest of the world.
